

For ASE Bath applicants

- The program is 5 weeks' long and students take two courses, earning 2 HWS credits. Students live in shared apartments and cook their own meals.
- The minimum gpa requirement is 3.0.
- You must apply directly to the professor running the seminar course you are interested in, not to ASE. Their professors' addresses are underneath the seminar course descriptions in the ASE brochure or on the ASE website at: http://www.studyabroadbath.org/drupal/ase_dev/?q=node/251
- Professors generally respond within a week or so after receiving your application. ASE said that if you don't hear back within a week to ten days or so after the professor would have received your application, you should feel free to email him or her.
- You need to include an official transcript and two faculty references with your application.
- The "Professor's Approval" signature line on the application form is for the professor who is running the program, so you can leave that blank.
- You will see that students are required to pay a deposit when they apply for an ASE program. **You do not need to send this in with your application. ASE will bill HWS for the fees later and we will bill you.**
- **The deadline for applying is February 18th at the latest but the programs fill on a first-come-first-served basis, so we recommend applying as early as possible.**
- The CGE has a limited amount of funding available for students in financial need. Please ask for a funding application from the CGE if you are interested in applying for this funding. You will need to apply to ASE, be accepted by them and hand in your acceptance letter along with the funding application before the funding deadline of November 15, 2010 to be eligible for CGE funding.

Students may only apply *two* credits from short-term study abroad programs to their HWS degree. They may petition the CGE in advance for a third course in exceptional circumstances.
