**Description:**

To all HWS network account users:

It has been brought to our attention that several people on campus received an e-mail requesting they type their password in a reply. This e-mail is signed the WEBMAIL Support Team, WEBMAIL WEBMAIL SUPPORT, WEBMAIL ADMINISTRATOR, or similar.

This message is NOT from HWS IT Services. We would never ask you to type out your password in an email and send it to us. We do not manage network or e-mail accounts in this manner. It is best practice to never share your password unless you verify, in person, that it is a legitimate request.
