Call for Exhibition Proposals

The Davis Gallery accepts submissions for exhibitions from emerging and established artists in all media. Proposals will be juried by the curator and the gallery committee. The deadline for submissions is **February 15th, 2020**. Artists should hear back by late-March of the year of submission. Exhibitions have typically run for 4 weeks, but a range between 3-8 weeks in duration is possible. Applications for both the Davis and Solarium Galleries are accepted.

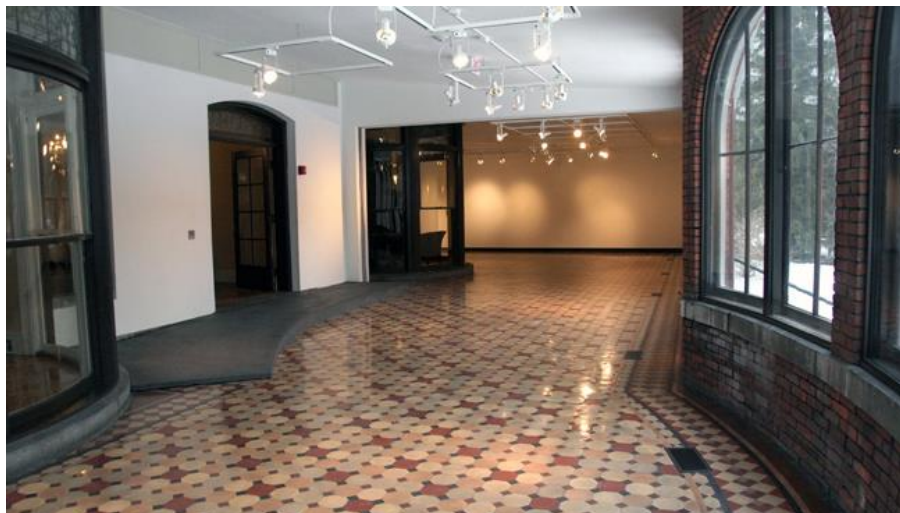
The exhibition proposal should address the following:

1. A general explanation of the artworks proposed
2. A statement of why you believe this show would be relevant to our community in terms of content and timing
3. The Davis Gallery is open during the academic year, from late August to late April. Please specify your preference, if any, for which semester (autumn or spring) you would like to exhibit. Please include if you would like staff and student help in installation and taking down the exhibition
4. A general outline of anticipated budget or related programming costs

The following materials must accompany this proposal as part of the Exhibition Prospectus, labeled with all pertinent information:

- Cover letter
- Biographical materials (resume, CV, proposal/description of work, artist statement)
- Press reviews, tear sheets, past postcard announcements, websites, Instagram, etc.
- 5 or more high resolution images (Images should represent a sampling of your current artwork)
