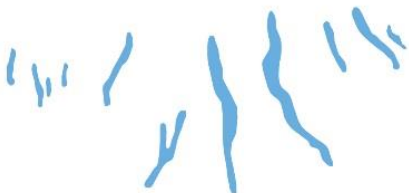

Project Elements	Possible Score	Score
Overall poster presentation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visual appeal • Use of images, graphics, tables and/or charts • Neatness 	20	
Research Question: How well thought out is the question? Does it provide new understanding to the topic?	10	
Background research: Does the presenter have diverse, multiple (more than three) references and complete citations?	10	
Methods: Are the methods described clearly so that another person could study the question using these methods?	10	
Data: Is there enough data to draw conclusions? Are the data represented in a way that is understandable? Are there labels, etc?	10	
Results: Is there an explanation of the data presented and what it means?	10	
Conclusions: Are there conclusions and do they provide a new understanding to the question posed? Does the student suggest further research questions?	10	
Communication: Does the student have a good understanding of the topic and did the student learn something from the experience?	20
