- 12) said person is prone to at least one kind of destructive pouting
- 13) said person is fit, trim, and undecided
- 14) said person lacks genitalia

- 17) said person is made antsy by the sale of safety-insuring devices

- 60) said person is offended by the idea of reasonable foundations
- said person has demonstrated an unusual grip on the usual, and is fond of reminiscing upon this demonstration
- 62) said person has a can-do attitude when it comes to creating the circumstances in which it is possible to drown
- 63) said person is conspicuously without blame with regard to the specific course taken by that which resists extinction almost successfully
- 64) said person feels his or her head looks "just right"
- 65) said person believes the word "person" signifies, above all, a mobile, vacant, and consistently endangered habitat
- 66) said person is melting
- 67) said person needs a place to stay
- 68) said person is a qualified but uncertifiable damage-sound coordinator
- 69) said person is willing to swear that he or she will adhere to all written restrictions, and to the spirit of hampered freedom in general
